

Summary – UNIITE Series

The Education Department at St. Cloud Hospital uses a 1 to 5 (*with five being the highest score*) rating scale for education that is offered to staff. It is our organization goal to have all education sessions receive an overall program rating of 4.5 or higher on that scale. More specific information is available in the evaluation summaries for each of the sessions, which are attached.

NOTE: *The first of the UNIITE sessions was done on a rating with 1 being the highest – that would equate to about a 4.2 rating for comparison purposes.*

Registration income varies for each session dependent on number pre-registered, those that registered for one class vs. the series, student rates, etc.

September 26, 2006 – **Lao Buddhist:** 22 people attended

1 to 5 scale (**1 being best score**)

Overall program rating: 1.92 (*4.2 comparator rating*)

Cost for this program: \$232 (*includes portion of brochure mailing, breakfast and handouts*)

Income from Registrations: \$450

October 10, 2006 – **South Asian Hindus:** 20 people attended

1 to 5 scale (*5 being best score*)

Overall program rating: 4.75

Cost for this program: \$220 (*includes portion of brochure mailing, breakfast and handouts*)

Income from Registrations: \$500

October 24, 2006 – **Lation/a Christians:** 29 people attended

1 to 5 scale (*5 being best score*)

Overall program rating: 4.28

Cost for this program: \$274 (*includes portion of brochure mailing, breakfast and handouts*)

Income from Registrations: \$627

November 7, 2006 – **Somali Muslims:** 34 people attended.

1 to 5 scale (*5 being best score*)

Overall program rating: 4.68

Cost for this program: \$304 (*includes portion of brochure mailing, breakfast and handouts*)

Income from Registrations: \$817

November 21, 2006 – **Hmong:** 25 people attended

1 to 5 scale (*being best score*)

Overall program rating: 4.95

Cost for this program: \$278 (*includes portion of brochure mailing, breakfast and handouts*)

Income from Registrations: \$670

The total out of pocket costs incurred by the Education Department were \$1,308. The registration income totaled \$3,064. This results in net income of \$1756.
